Storing Clean Clothes

Project Summary/Details	<i>An ongoing problem in dorm laundry rooms is that students will throw their clothes in the dryer, go to class, and not get back until later in the day. Meanwhile, other students need to dry their clothes. Since there's no designated place to put these clothes taking up dryer space, students will put these clean clothes on top of washers, or worse on the ground, undermining the fact they have just been cleaned. My proposed solution: purchase durable hampers that will be drilled in place or branded and placed in laundry rooms, so students have a place to put clothes pulled out of the dryer. Ideally, we would have one hamper per dryer, as space allows. Dean Sager's proposed solution: instead of hampers, install lockers or open shelving. Each laundry room in Talge, Thatcher, and Thatcher South should have whatever agreed upon solution provided. This solution would be provided as soon as the solution is agreed upon by Senate.</i>
Estimated cost	<i>Hampers: $34 * \\$21.31 = 724.54$ + tax + shipping Cost for plant services to install: ~5 hours of work</i>
Timeframe	<i>Project is not urgent; however, hampers would be ordered within a week of being voted in, and installed as soon as they arrive, and plant services can get to it.</i>
