Proposal Details	Intro: Currently, the only avenue for students to post projects or make comments on Senate is by directly talking to their Senator, or by personally handing in a project proposal to the Senate office. There is no consistent, anonymous platform for students to share ideas or concerns with Senate. With open-mindedness as a core principle, Senate needs a more effective way to facilitate conversation. Main Idea: As part of the <i>You Matter</i> campaign, Senate will add a link on the Senate website to a form that students can fill out and submit anonymously online. Specs: The Social Committee will finalize what the form and link will look like.
