IV. Project Proposal – Nyah Jackson

Buying and Installing a New TV

SUMMARY: Senate would purchase a new TV for the School of Journalism and Communication to display news and announcements in the hallway.

PROBLEM:

The TV that is currently installed in this spot is no longer working.

This TV is important because it is used to display the news as well as important announcements to students while they are walking to and from class.

It is 15 years old:0

SOLUTION: Purchasing the Samsung QH55C 55" 4K UHD Commercial Monitor. This the standard for the University, already being ordered by Sewell

UPDATE!

The TV was already bought and installed. The price decreased significantly! New Motion - "I move to approve giving \$525 for a new TV in the School of Journalism and Communications."

V. Project Proposal – Heidi Burke (voting)

Bike Racks for Upper Stateside Proposal

SUMMARY: Senate will partner with University Finance to purchase 6 Belson Outdoors 9 Capacity Bike Racks with installation kits for the Upper Stateside Apartments.

PROBLEM: Upper Stateside, which includes the Tennessee, Mississippi, and Kentucky apartments, with 96 residents total, does not have any bike racks.

This creates several problems:

• Opportunity for theft

- Safety hazards inside and outside
- Damage to stairs, floor, and walls
- Inconvenience and hassle

SOLUTION:

- 1. Buy and install 6 bike racks
- 2. 3 apartments with 2 doors each = 6 racks

Price and Shipping Information

- There is a graduated pricing system
 - o The cost for buying and shipping 2units is \$1,424.23
 - o \$1,026 for units
 - o \$398.23 for shipping (this excludes tax)
 - o The cost for buying and shipping 6 units is \$3,495.51
 - o \$3,018.00 for units
 - o \$477.51 for shipping (this excludes tax)

There is only a \$79.28 shipping cost increase for purchasing all the units at the same time Buying all the units simultaneously saves SAU hundreds of dollars.

PROPOSAL FOR UNIVERSITY:

Senate will cover the cost of 2 units (\$503 each) and the total cost of shipping (\$477.51)

- o Total of \$1483.51
- O Southern will cover the cost of 4 units (\$503 each) and the cost of the installation kits (approx. \$55 each, 6 needed)
- o Total of approx. \$2342

This proposal was approved by Vinnie Schober, Associate Vice President for Financial Administration

IMPLEMENTATION

- Mark Antone, Director of Landscaping, said that installation costs will be absorbed by the Landscaping Department.
- Tennessee apartment already has two concrete slabs ready for bike racks. This allows for immediately installation.
- Mississippi and Kentucky still need concrete slabs installed. However, having the bike racks ready and University investment will raise the priority of purchasing these slabs.

MOTION: I move to approve Senate partnering with University Financial Administration to purchase 6 Belson Outdoors 9 Capacity Bike Racks with installation kits for the Upper Stateside Apartments.

DISCUSSION 5 minutes

1. Nyah: Once we purchase these, they will be inclined to add the concrete slabs? Will that be guaranteed?

Heidi: they can't install this in the winter, and this is due tot he weather but they are able to address it and that it would be in the summer.

2. Havin: You are mentioning that we are buying 6 bikeracks, each hold 9. Is there a need for that many in that amount.

Heidi: The sir was introducing that idea for 6 being necessary. Because he is concerned with people placing them incorrectly, instead of how it is intended, a bicycle rack.

- 3. Kalla: Can you expand on where the concrete slabs will be placed?

 Heidi: By the door in front of the square of concrete. This will also be an intentional spot where we will reduce the place where there may be injury
- 4. Houston: This is a good investment, why won't we install this in other housing Heidi: My constituents are from stateside, so I prioritized that. But That might be another proposal.
- 5. Tata: The number isn read that this expires in the end of the month, will those change Heidi: This proposal was made for. The prices really don't fluctuate that much
